

Literary and Scientific Association (associated with the Chartist Church, Glasgow)

Overview

There is little currently known about this association. The article in the *Northern Star* mentions that there were three Chartist churches in Glasgow at the time ('Chartist Intelligence. Glasgow', *Northern Star and Leeds General Advertiser*, 31 July 1841, p. 2). To date, it is unknown which church the group was associated with.
